



SCHOOL UNIFORMS

BALLET

As always, Nunnbetter Dance Theatre requires a class uniform for ballet students Level Ballet 1 - Intermediate Ballet. This year, NDT has changed our level uniforms, both style and colors.

All students registered in the Ballet program will need to fill out the uniform survey regarding the level which you are entering and sizing. NDT will then place the order for your uniform which consists of a leotard and skirt. Your CC on file will be charged a [\\$55](#) uniform fee with the [October 1st](#) tuition.

All ballet students are also required to have pink tights and pink ballet shoes. NDT has a limited supply of Bloch tights for sale at \$10 per pair, both in children and adult sizes.

Please remember that all ballet students must have their hair neatly pulled back and secured in a neat bun. If you have shorter hair, your hair must be pulled away from your face and secured with clips or a headband.

JAZZ, THEATER DANCE, BROADWAY

Dancers enrolled in Jazz and Theater Dance should wear a leotard and tights and black jazz shoes for class. They can also wear Jazz pants over their leotard and tights, or jazz shorts. No midriff dance tops please.

HIP HOP

Dancers enrolled in Hip Hop should wear comfortable clothing to move in. They do not necessarily need to wear leotard and tights, but they should wear clothing that is not constricting and has a free feeling. Also, Hip Hop dancers will need black converse high top sneakers as their dance shoes. We ask that these are kept for dance and not worn outside the studio. No dancer will be allowed in with regular street shoes.

MODERN and CONTEMPORARY

Dancers enrolled in Contemporary and Modern will dance barefoot. Leotard with convertible tights (the foot portion of the tights can be rolled up off, exposing the foot) are suggested.

WHAT IS NOT ALLOWED

At Nunnbetter Dance Theater, we ask that dancers do not wear half top /sports bra type of tops. We ask that if it is cold and you need warm up clothing, that you choose an appropriate dance sweater or t -shirt type of clothing, not a big bulky hoodie or jacket.

Ballet classes do not allow baggy pants or warm up pants.

Hair must always be secured away from face.

And ABSOLUTELY NO GUM in the studio at any time.
