

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What age is "Tiny"?

A: "Tiny" classes are perfect for the 5-7 year old.

Q: What ages is "Kids"?

A: "Kids" is an 8-11 age range.

Q: What is the difference between Ballet 4 Fast Track and General?

A: If you have completed Ballet 3 you have the choice of trying either Ballet 4 Fast Track or General. Ballet 4 Fast track is a mandatory two classes per week (Tuesday and Thursday). General Ballet 4 is on Friday and cannot be one of the two Fast Track classes. Usually we encourage younger Ballet 4 students (8, 9, even some 10 yr. old's) to take the general class and then take Ballet 4 Fast Track the next year.

Q: What should I do if I have never taken class at Nunnbetter Dance Theatre before, or want to take a new style of dance?

A: Register for a free trial class. This is a great way for new dancers to try things, and returning dancers to try new styles. Also, if you have questions, email Ms. Kim at Kim@NunnbetterDance.com

Q: How will I know what Ballet uniform I need? Is it the same as in past years?

A: Once you register you will be asked information regarding your leotard size. NDT will collect a \$55 uniform fee and will provide you with a level-based leotard and matching skirt. Uniforms have been changed this year. There are new colors and styles.

Q: Do I need a uniform for other style classes?

A: NDT does not require a certain color leotard etc. for classes other than ballet. However, NDT does have uniform requirements for shoes for all classes, and rules about warm up wear, messy clothing, hair and other attire. We will make sure to post all class requirements.

Q: Why is there no tap this year?

A: This was a really hard decision this year, but at last year's enrollment levels, it did not make sense for us to schedule tap this year.
